Massachusetts K-12 schools are set to receive **\$3.5 million dollars** to spend exclusively on local, unprocessed or lightly processed foods.

This one-time funding will be available to schools beginning in the spring of 2023 and schools will have 18 months to spend the funds. The funding is part of the USDA's Local Food For Schools program.
