About the bill

The Farm to School Grant Bill, entitled, "An Act establishing farm to school grants to promote healthy eating and strengthen the agricultural economy," (HD.558 and SD.243.) is a competitive grant program within the Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education that would provide eligible schools and early education and care programs the critical funds needed to start up or expand farm to school activities. The program would support the infrastructure investments, staff training, and educational initiatives that lead to farm to school program success and sustainability. This grant program would allow for the continuation of the pilot MA FRESH grants program currently resourced through ARPA funding until 2024 Download a fact sheet here.
